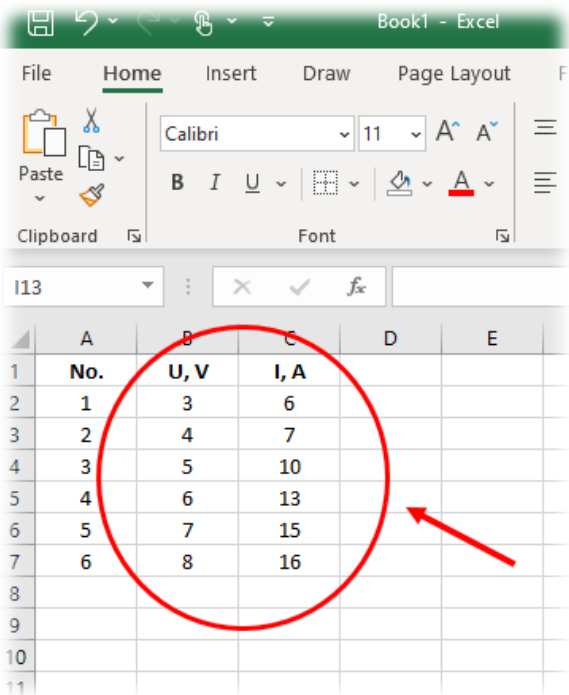
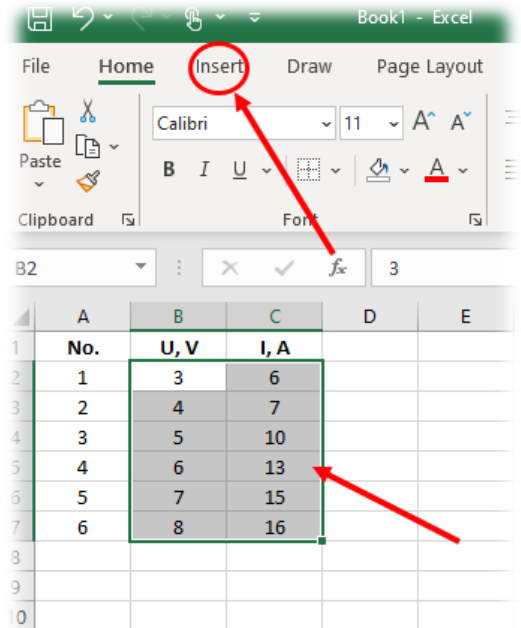


Excel instructions

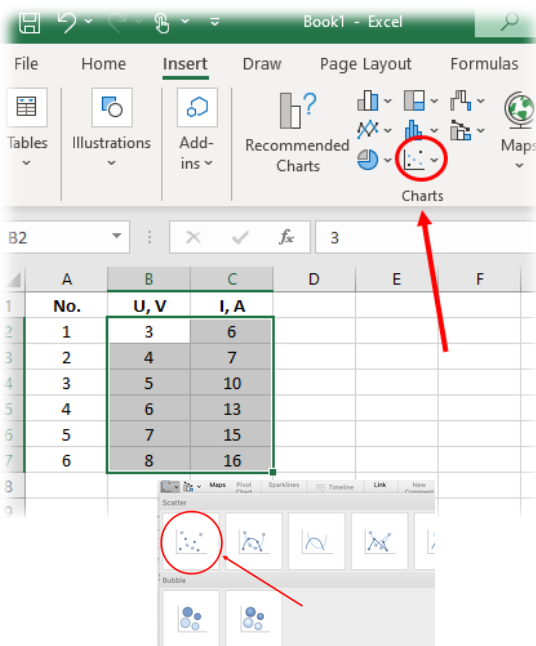
1. Make a table with data you want to plot in a scatter chart. Make sure that quantity on the horizontal axis is on the left column and quantity on the vertical axis is on the right column.



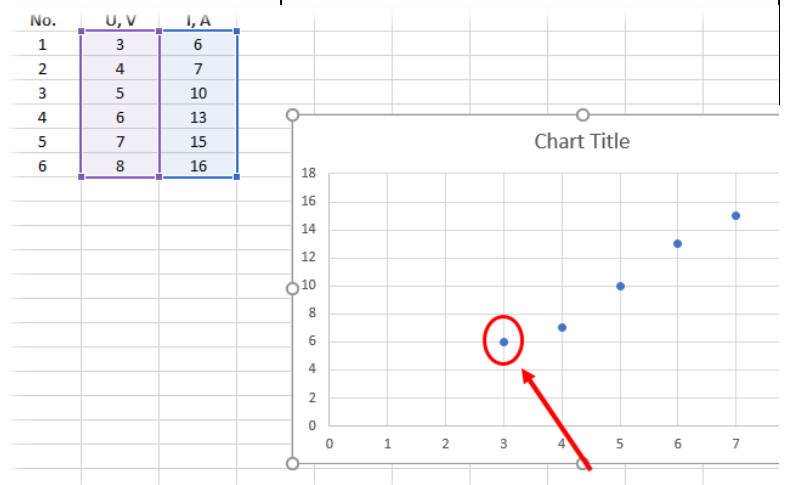
2. Select the data you want to plot in the scatter chart and click "Insert".



3. Click Insert Scatter and choose the type you want.



4. Right-click on one of the data points and choose "Add Trendline..."



5. Choose function type you need and press “Display Equation on chart” to get the equation that describe the function on the screen. If you loose the window where you can format trendline options, just double click on the trendline.
